

Somewhere in Seidenburg
Oct 21, 1948

Dear Mother, Dad & all,

Just a few lines to let you know that I am OK and still getting along fine. Still haven't received any mail for quite some time. I sure hope I hit the jackpot when I do get some. It gets monotonous to write and not receive any mail. I hope you are getting my letters a lot faster than I get yours.

Haven't flown any since I last wrote to you, in fact, I haven't done much of anything. It's nice and clear tonight, maybe we will get to fly tomorrow. I'll sure be glad to get flying again.

Yesterday afternoon, four of us went in town and ate some ice cream, had dinner and drank a few beers. I don't know whether I told you or not, but we can get ice cream and beer here. The ice cream isn't as good as we got at home, but it's at least ice cream. The beer is about like the 3.2 we get at home.

I still haven't received the Daily News yet, maybe when the mail comes through I will get some. I sure hope so.

Here are a few Nazi insignia I picked up the other day. As soon as I get some other stuff, I will send it home.

Take good care of yourselves and tell everyone I said "Hello."
