Nov 28, 1944

Dear Mother, Dad & All,

Just a few lines to let you know that I am OK and getting along fine. Haven't been getting much mail lately, but it should be coming in soon.

Still no packages or Daily News yet. I sure hope they start rolling around before long.

Been kind of lazy of late and I haven't done too much writing. I answer all my letters, but I haven't been writing any extra ones like I did for awhile.

We hardly know how to act any more. This is the longest time we have spent in one place since we came over. There for awhile, it seemed like we would just about get settled when we would have to move.

Had a few good days in the last week, so we got a little flying time. It's raining again so I guess we won't get up for a few days.

Got a nice long letter from Pat the other day. He told me that you had written him a nice long letter. He ~~told~~ ^{tried} to tell you he said "Hello"

There has been so few things of interest taking place over here, that it leaves me little to write about. I should get a letter from you tomorrow, so I will write more when I answer it.

Well, I guess that's about all, so I will close. Take good care of yourselves and tell everyone I said "Hello!"
