Got a letter from Bill and he seems to be getting along O.K. As far as I know, he is still in the same place in France.

They finally located our footlockers and sent a truck after them. They were supposed to be back today but they never did come. I hope that mine is among them when they do get back.

The snow is about all gone now. It rained awhile yesterday and today, and what a mess. The ~~road~~ we all covered with slush and mud. Seemed like it was getting colder this evening. It sure will be a mess if it freezes.

About a week ago I got a ~~letter~~ Xmas card from Mr & Mrs Barnham and Winifred. I don't know them well enough to write to them, so thank them for me and tell them I appreciated their card very much.
