the fellow that owned him had left for home. We sure hated to see him get killed, but I think it was best, cause he was just about going mad trying to find Charlie.

There isn't anything I could get you over here and you know what you want and need - I think there is enough of my money at home to cover it. Happy birthday to you and many of them!
