Dear Mother, Dad & all,

Sorry to keep you waiting so long, but as you can see from the above, we have been a little busy for the past week. We are the first squadron of the first air corp group to be operating from Germanny. It's a pretty nice place here, although it is pretty badly blown up. When the Germans build a field they don't stand short on a thing. I'd sure like to see one of their fields before it was blown up.

Haven't been off the field yet although I intend to get out and look around. We have been kept pretty busy trying to get set up.

A couple of us took a little time out to get our hair cut and what a clipping we got. Won't have to use a comb for quite some time - feels good though.

Thanks a lot for the photo corners, they will come in mighty handy. I can't understand whatever became of the packages, I haven't received any yet. It burns me up too, cause all of those packages just don't.

Been eating and feeling a lot better since we got here. There's nothing like this outdoor life. The first day we dug a latrine, the first work I have done in ages - didn't even have any sore muscles the ~~for~~ next day.
